



Rapeseed is a cool season winter annual in the brassica family used in many cover crop mixes. It is easy to establish via drill, broadcast or aerial application is fast growing in the fall, and has a sizeable fibrous root system including several root hair offshoots that help break compaction. Rapeseed is planted later than radishes, and will often survive the winter to continue soaking up nutrients in the spring.
