PURPLE TOP TURNIP

Established in mid- to late summer, Purple Top Turnips are used for grazing early fall into late winter. Turnips and annual ryegrass make a good fall feed when broadcast into corn or soybeans before harvest. The turnip tops and bulbs are both edible, highly digestible and a good source of sulfur.
